IDENTIFYING & DEVELOPING EMERGING YOUNG LEADERS

The last sixty years has seen the church in Australia diminishing rapidly. However, in the last ten years, studies show that the few churches that are growing have something in common: They identify emerging leaders early, and provide the support and pathways to see them through to formal leadership roles in our community. The future of Christian faith in Australia is dependent upon us nurturing leadership from within our communities of faith, not relying on hiring from elsewhere. But no church or school can do it on their own. So, when is leadership identified, encouraged & developed...

AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE!!!

Now in its 9th year, Youth Leadership Week combines action oriented team based activities with input from the Bible, small groups, reflection, coaching & stories from some of the best trainers of young leaders in South Australia.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

- Years 10- 12 aged students who are enthusiastic and showing leadership potential already
- 18-23 years olds with some experience of leadership, and wanting to go further

WHAT IF THEY HAVE COME BEFORE?

Youth Leadership Week has 3 years of incremental development. So campers can continue to come to camp from year 10 –12.

- 1st year campers:** Personal Leadership Skills
- 2nd year campers:** Group Leadership Skills
- 3rd year campers:** Assistant on-camp mentoring

LEADERSHIP SKILLS

On camp, emerging leaders are taught how to:

- # Lead a discussion
- # Lead a Bible study
- # Lead a devotion
- # Give a short talk
- # Lead a group



OTHER KEY FEATURES OF YLW CAMP

- Evening guest speakers who are inspiring Christian leaders beyond the church walls
 - Mission Agency speed dating! An hour of rapid interviews with people who can help emerging leaders serve God in amazing ways locally or overseas

AFTER CAMP

Feedback: All nominators will receive comprehensive feedback on how each sent Emerging Leader or On-Camp Mentor went with recommendations on what next steps and options will help their continued support and growth.

Mentoring: Youth Leadership Week sets up emerging leaders with 12 months of mentoring after camp. Mentoring is critical for the cycle of action and reflection as it helps young people to keep growing through success or failure.



CHURCH & SCHOOL PARTNERSHIPS

Churches & schools play a key role in the development of emerging young leaders. Because of this, participants must be 'sent' by their church or school with the understanding that nominators will give emerging leaders appropriate new opportunities to lead after camp. Youth Leadership Week equips and inspires each emerging leader to be ready for that challenge. State level personnel from many organisations and denominations are involved with YLW to give your emerging leaders the best support possible.

MISSION FOCUS!

We aim to inspire young people to participate in what GOD is doing through Jesus, in rescuing & transforming HIS world. The church & school neighbourhood are two meaningful places where this can happen. Young people can do amazing things. YLW will help them identify mission opportunities, and how to pursue these in partnership with local churches & Pastoral Support Workers.
